Advanced Tracker Technologies IncCommand-line Parameters for Employee Tracker

Overview

This document describes the various command-line parameters which can be passed to the Employee Tracker application (Etp.Exe).

The use of the parameters in this document is not recommended, as Employee Tracker should run fine without any of them present. Please be sure you speak to a technical contact at Advanced Tracker prior to implementing any of them.

Parameter Setup

The parameters listed in this document can be easily applied to an existing shortcut pointing to Etp.Exe. To see or change the parameters, right-click on the shortcut and select the "Properties" menu item. From the Shortcut tab, observe the "Target" box.

A simple target may read (including the quotation marks):

```
"C:\Program Files\Etp\Etp.Exe"
```

Addition of parameters to the application would be amended to the target after the last quotation mark. For example:

```
"C:\Program Files\Etp\Etp.Exe" /SKIPIT
```

Notice that an initial space is required prior to the first parameter, but after the quotation mark.

Multiple parameters can be used, but must be separated by a space. For example:

"C:\Program Files\Etp\Etp.Exe" /SKIPIT MAINBLANK

The Parameters

/SKIPIT

Ignore permission checks

USENETLIB=xxxx

SQL Server 2000 database only.

Force client database connection protocol. See the SQL Server 2000 administration document for more details.

/FORCEETPATH=" path"

Access databases only.

Use a specific path to the data.

/COMPACTANDREPAIR

Access databases only.

Force a compact and repair.

FORCED

Access databases only.

Force the Database Merlin to run.

OLDPROF

Force old-style employee profile

NOREGIONALADJUST

Do not attempt to adjust the regional settings, just run with the system defaults

MAINBLANK

No image on the main menu window, just a blank screen. May improve repaints on thin-client installations (eg. Terminal Services, Citrix).
